



Stage 1



- Engage with local community and local organisations seeking 'new blood' and different age groups.
- Form a steering group.
- Develop a fundraising strategy for a feasibility study and outline proposals with the participation of the community.
- Raise the funds.

Stage 2



- Begin the process and draw in new participants:
 - an initial exhibition of The Causey.
 - Community workshops for the general public, young people (Canongate Youth Project), school children and a local heritage group.
 - Communication and record the process: our web site, newsletters, flyers/posters.
 - Identify any issues (roads, consents, procedures).
- Develop outline proposals:
 - Sketch designs;
 - Budget costing.

Stage 3



- Consult with agencies (City of Edinburgh Council etc):
 - Community;
 - Exhibition;
 - Feedback.
- Develop final design proposals:
 - Costings;
 - Outline specification;
 - Consents.
- Establish a budget for fundraising.
- Develop a fundraising strategy.
- Detail the design
 - Specification;
 - Bill of quantities;
 - Costings.
- Open to tenders.
- Implementation on site.
